CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION



- a) The First Fleet Cavalcade through the Clem 7 Tunnel event (the “Event”) is to be run and organised by the Organising Committee of The Rotary Club of Stones Corner Inc (the Organising Committee”).
- b) The number of vehicles that will be chosen to participate in the Event will be determined by the Organising Committee.
- c) The amount of the donation received by the due date will determine the position of the vehicle in the Event.
- d) If two donations of the same amount are received the final position will be determined by the earlier date and time of the receipt of donation in the nominated Rotary PayPal Account.
- e) Donations must be deposited using PayPal within 24hrs of the documents being lodged with the Organising Committee.
- f) All entrants and nominated vehicles must be members or associated with the car club they represent.
- g) The nominated vehicle must be:
 - (i) a generic model of the car club it represents;
 - (ii) registered in the appropriate category;
 - (iii) covered by a current comprehensive motor vehicle insurance policy;
 - (iv) of showcase condition; and
 - (v) in sound mechanical and safe condition.
- h) The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse participation to any vehicle/owner who do not meet these Conditions of Participation.
- i) If a vehicle selected to participate in the Event or nominated driver is not able to attend on the Event day then a replacement vehicle or nominated driver meeting these Conditions of Participation may be substituted no less than 24 hrs prior to the Event, subject to the approval of the Organising Committee.
- j) The nominated driver must have a current driver’s licence.
- k) The vehicle can carry any legal number of passengers in the vehicle depending on the licence class of the driver.
- l) The driver must not deliberately stop the vehicle in the CLEM7 tunnel. If a vehicle stops in the CLEM7 tunnel due to reasons outside the control of the driver, the driver must make every attempt to move to the left and all occupants must wait inside the vehicle for assistance, unless it is dangerous to do so or they are otherwise directed by an Event marshal.
- m) Drivers must obey instructions given by Event marshals or risk disqualification from the Event.
- n) The Event will occur on a Saturday. The earliest date for the Event is February 13th 2010 but may be rescheduled to a later date. Donations and applications are accepted on the condition that vehicles and nominated drivers will make every effort to be available on every Saturday and Sunday until March 27th 2010.
- o) Applications will not be received after 12.00 pm on the notified closing date.
- p) Notification and details of your participation will be emailed to you no later than 12.00 pm within three days of the notified closing date.
- q) A receipt for payment of the donation, or refund of the paid donation if your application is unsuccessful, will be issued within 14 days after the Event.
- r) If a dispute arises, the Organising Committee will adjudicate and its decision will be final. There is no right of appeal.

- s) **IMPORTANT – LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY:** Owners, drivers and their passengers:
- (i) acknowledge and accept that they enter and participate in the Event at their own risk; and
 - (ii) agree to release and save harmless the Organising Committee, the Rotary Club of Stones Corner Inc., RiverCity Motorway Group, Leighton Contractors and Boulderstone Hornibrook Bilfinger Berger Joint Venture and the Brisbane City Council and their agents officers employees and contractors from and against all liabilities, losses, damages, costs (including legal costs) and expenses due to or arising out of:
 - (1) their entry and participation in the Event;
 - (2) the acts or omissions of other persons;
 - (3) any happening or accident;
 - (4) negligence on the part of the Organising Committee, the Rotary Club of Stones Corner Inc., RiverCity Motorway Group, Leighton Contractors and Boulderstone Hornibrook Bilfinger Berger Joint Venture or the Brisbane City Council or any of their respective agents officers employees or contractors;
 - (5) damage to or destruction of their property or the property of other persons from any cause;
 - (6) additionally and without limiting the application of the other provisions of this condition s)(ii) in respect of personal injury or death, negligence on the part of the Organising Committee, the Rotary Club of Stones Corner Inc., RiverCity Motorway Group, Leighton Contractors and Boulderstone Hornibrook Bilfinger Berger Joint Venture or the Brisbane City Council or any of their respective agents officers employees or contractors. Owners, drivers and their passengers acknowledge and accept that the Event is a leisure-time pursuit undertaken for the purpose of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.
- t) In the event that any of the terms contained in these Conditions of Participation are determined to be invalid or unenforceable to any extent, such term shall be severed from the body of these Conditions of Participation which shall continue to be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by the law.
