## MAY RUN: Fort Lytton, 16/05/21

Finally a month without lockdowns and run interruptions, we were lucky to get out for a combined run with CHACC, out to the historic Fort Lytton. The morning started for some at the usual spot of Caboolture Lakes, where I imagine the typical chin wag ensued. For our party, we decided to head straight to the venue to avoid doubling back.

It was an easy drive up the highway and we soon arrived at Fort Lytton which is tucked away in some back roads behind the Ampol Terminal. Fort Lytton defended Brisbane continuously from colonial times until after WW2. It's Queensland's foremost military exhibit, with extensive historic fortifications and multiple military museums.

Upon our arrival we were briefed by the top brass in charge of the tour. We started by the main shed looking at some of the artillery that was on display and then moved on to some of the battery installations that were in place. The historic fort consists of about a hectare of colonial buildings, tunnels, and other fortified structures embedded in a protective earth-mound wall and surrounded by a 10m-wide water-filled moat.

It was a fascinating tour only made more interesting by our tour guide who was both knowledgeable and funny. We also got to see many cannons, including the legendary disappearing gun.

Once the tour concluded, we moved over to one of the museums, where we saw war time weaponry and various items, some of which we needed to enquire about because we were unsure of their purpose. Soon lunch beckoned. It was great for the two clubs to sit together, enjoy our lunch, and have a chat.

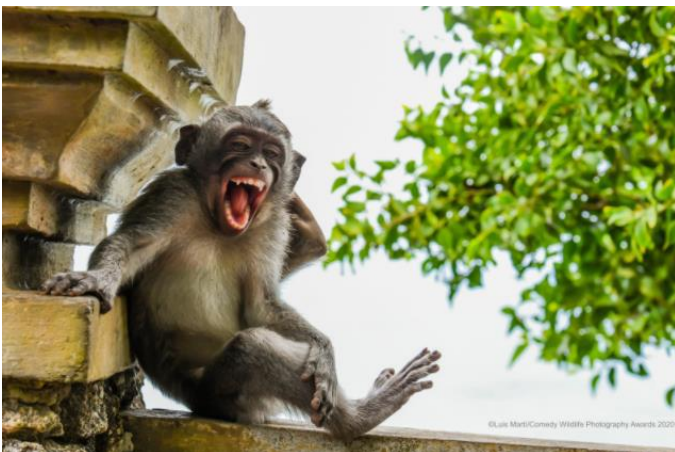
Thank you to Alex and Bob for organising an excellent run and thank you to members of CHACC for joining the run.
